

Legend Oaks Golf Club Pool Rules & Regulations

<u>Violation of any of the Legend Oaks or SCDHEC pool rules and regulations</u> May result in loss of privileges, without right to a refund and possible fines.

Pool facilities are for the use of Legend Oaks Golf & Tennis Club Members & authorized guests only.

Pool Hours – Monday - Sunday

April – October – 10:00 am to 8:30 pm

Deck Only hours

November – March – 10:00 am to Dusk

Legend Oaks Swim Team shares the pool during swim season.

Practice/meet schedules are posted on website calendar and at the pool!

Numbered membership fob(s) are required for entry to the Pool. <u>Use of Fob(s) by someone other</u> than the assigned member is strictly prohibited, without a Valid Pool Pass.

Each member family is entitled to a reasonable number of <u>Daily Guest Passes</u> per season. No more than five guests per visit. Guest passes must be picked up at the Legend Oaks Golf Club Membership Office or Pro Shop prior to entering the pool. **Guests may not live in Legend Oaks or the surrounding communities** without prior approval from management.

All members and their guests must sign in/out on the Pool Attendance Log prior to entering/leaving the pool, including member name and fob number.

Children under the age of 14 must be accompanied by an adult eighteen years or older at all times.

No life guard will be present. Swim at your own risk.

Appropriate swim attire is required. No cut-offs or shorts are permitted in the pool.

Disposable diapers are **NOT** allowed in the pool. Pool approved infant/toddler swim safety diapers/pants are allowed.

Food and drink is permitted on the pool deck only. <u>NO GLASS CONTAINERS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED INSIDE THE GATED POOL AREA!</u>

Smoking is **NOT** permitted in the pool or on the pool deck.

Jumping, diving off the sides backwards or doing flips of any kind is not permitted.

Climbing, Jumping or Diving off Pergolas Will Result in <u>Membership Suspension!</u>

All members and guests must follow the posted "Pool Rules" as governed by the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control.

Abuse and/or vandalism to any Legend Oaks Golf Club property, equipment or facilities is strictly prohibited.

Legend Oaks Golf Club is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of personal property.

Legend Oaks Golf Club reserves the right to close the pool due to inclement weather, private parties, swim team practice, pool contamination, pool maintenance, etc.

Important Entry and Exit Information Using Fobs!

Enter the Pool Facility:

Swipe Key Fob across the Control Pad (A) at the front gate and walk in when the gate opens.

Exit the Pool Facility:

Push the Exit Button **(B)** located on the pole near the Kiddie Pool and walk to the gate. Exit when the gate opens.

Key Fobs work during posted open pool hours only! You must exit the pool at the designated close time. There is a short grace period to exit the pool before your Fob will no longer work.

In case of an emergency only a member of management will be able to let you in or out of the pool after hours. Call the Clubhouse for assistance at 843-821-4077 ext 100 or 102.





South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control Pool Safety Rules

- (a) Pool Rules Sign. A "Pool Rules" sign for informational purposes must be posted in a conspicuous place in the pool area and must contain, as a minimum, the items listed below, with the blanks reflected in (xii) through (xv) below filled in before authorized operation:
 - (i) There should be no solo swimming.
 - (ii) There should be no running, boisterous or rough play.
 - (iii) No person under the influence of alcohol or drugs should use the pool.
 - (iv) There should be no spitting or blowing nose in pool.
 - (v) Persons with diarrhea illness or nausea should not enter the pool.
 - (vi) Persons with skin, eye, ear or respiratory infections should not enter the pool.
 - (vii) Persons with open lesions or wounds should not enter the pool.
 - (viii) No animals or pets allowed in the pool.
 - (ix) No glass allowed in the pool or on the deck.
 - (x) No children should be in the pool without supervision.
 - (xi) You should take a shower before entering the pool.
 - (xii) This pool is open from 10:00 a.m. to 8:30p.m. April-October and

Pool Deck is open from 10:00 a.m. to Dusk November-March

- (xiii) The maximum number of swimmers allowed in the pool is 150.
 - (xiii) A first aid kit is located above the water cooler next to the restrooms.
 - (xv) An emergency phone (or other notification device) is located on the wall in front of the restrooms.
 - (xvi) Life saving equipment is located on the trellis by the restrooms (life ring) and near the fence at the shallow end of the pool (shepherds hook).
