## 2020 Tournament Eligibility

Legend Oaks Golf Club is proud to host a variety of golf tournaments to welcome all golfers to the game. Under the USGA guidelines our main goal is to create a fair and consistent environment. We appreciate your support in all Legend Oaks Golf Tournaments and would like you to be aware of our major tournament schedule.

### Legend Oaks Tournament Majors

- Singles Matchplay - March
- Legends Cup - April
- Legend Oaks Invitational - May
- 4 - Ball Matchplay - September
- Club Championship - September
- Member - Member - October

Legend Oaks and the Handicap Committee recognize these tournaments as majors and therefore will be posted as a “Tournament Score” by the Golf Shop and the Committee.

### Handicap Revision

For all 2020 Legend Oaks Golf Tournaments, the golfers low handicap index from the previous 3 months will be used. This is the preferred method from the Carolina Golf Association as it ensures Handicap Index consistency.

### Handicap Committee / Score Posting

The Legend Oaks Handicap Committee main role is to “*Peer Review*” rounds played vs. rounds posted to GHIN. For our Members to compete in our major tournament schedule they must have a compliance of **rounds post vs. round played**. A monthly report on rounds posted vs. rounds played will be posted on our Legend Oaks Website.

### What are the rounds played vs rounds posted compliance?

Legend Oaks and the Handicap Committee expects all golfers to be at 100% compliance with rounds played vs rounds posted when it falls under the USGA guidelines to post a score, any golfer that is not in compliance and wants to compete in Legend Oaks Tournament, should expect one of the following:

- Adjustment to Handicap Index for the Tournament
- Longer handicap index revision (e.g. 6,9 or 12-month revision)

When do I not post a score?

- While being coached on the course
- Fewer than 7 holes are played
- When the number or type of golf club to be used is restricted
- When score cannot be verified by another person
- When a player does not play their own ball. Examples Captains Choice

No GHIN Handicap / Non-Member

- Must have a valid USGA GHIN Handicap. (If you don't have one you will be given the same index as the best golfer in the event)
- Must have "GHIN Home Club" Head Golf Professional verify your Handicap Index
