

Tennis Court Rules

Tennis facilities are for the use of Legend Oaks Golf and Tennis Club Members and authorized guests only.

Hours of Play are: 7:00 am to 10:00 pm

Court reservations may be made by members in good standing only. Reservations may be made up to 7 days in advance through the Legend Oaks Court Reservation Online System or App (Follow instructions on our "Members Only" page to register for online court reservation system) or contact the Pro Shop. Walk on play is permitted if the court is not reserved. USTA scheduled home matches and lessons take precedence over walk on play.

Courts may be reserved by members for up to 1 1/2 hours for singles and up to 2 hours for doubles.

All USTA League team captains must be members of Legend Oaks Golf and Tennis Club. All team member and league members must be current with required fees before they attend a practice or play a match.

All guests must be accompanied by a member on the court at all times.

Appropriate tennis attire on the court is required at all times including tennis shoes and shirts.

Any use of the courts for sports activities other than tennis is not permitted.

All members and guests play at their own risk.

Legend Oaks Golf and Tennis Club is not responsible for loss, damage or theft of personal property.

Legend Oaks Golf and Tennis Club reserves the right to close the courts for maintenance and club events.

Violation of any of the court rules may result in loss of privileges and/or fines. If a youth has to be reprimanded on his behavior at the courts by a Legend Oaks Staff Member, the incident will be reported to his/her parents.

Please wait until play is finished before walking across a court to get to your court. Be prompt in sending back any stray balls from adjacent courts. Do not leave any trash on the courts, including balls, ball cans, and can tops. If you are the last court at night, please turn off the lights.

We are a family club with quite a few juniors. Swearing on the court, throwing racquets, loud outbursts or arguing is not allowed.

Formal tennis lessons are to be provided only by the Tennis Director or his designate.
