1st Annual Dave Scott Memorial Golf Tournament, Hosted by Legend Oaks Gives Back at Legend Oaks Golf & Tennis Club, Raises \$5,031 for Charleston Youth Hockey Association.

Summerville, SC: The 1st Annual Dave Scott Memorial Golf Tournament and Dinner was held May 19th, 2018. The event, benefiting the Charleston Youth Hockey Association, raised \$5,031 to support the youth hockey in the Lowcountry. The Legend Oaks Gives Back initiative sponsored the inaugural event.

Dave Scott, a long time member at Legend Oaks Golf & Tennis Club, passed away on April 15th, 2018 at the age of 70, after a battle with cancer. Dave served 32 years a firefighter and captain for the Mississauga Fire Department outside of Toronto, Canada. Dave loved to travel and play golf. He was always a hockey fan, and after retiring to Summerville, SC over 20 years ago, Dave became a huge fan of the South Carolina Stingrays. Marie, Dave's beloved wife, chose to honor Dave's life with a charity golf tournament and dinner, benefitting the Charleston Youth Hockey Association. With just a few weeks of planning, the event was so successful Marie has now vowed to continue the tradition with an annual tournament honoring Dave and benefiting youth hockey players in the Lowcountry.

The Golf Tournament opened with a shotgun start for with 78 players in the field. The 18-hole Captain's Choice tournament included many forms of "upgrades" for the players to enhance their game, such as mulligans, skip your ball across the pond and more! Prizes were awarded for Longest Drive and Closest to the Pin, along with honors for the top three teams. First place went to the team of Keith Sloan, Andrew Sloan, Ben Sloan and Gordon Frederickson. Following golf, a scotch tasting and a door prize drawing was enjoyed by 120 attendees who were served a steak dinner, Dave's favorite.

The designated beneficiary charity, Charleston Youth Hockey Association, is a 503(c)3 organization with a mission for "The promotion, image, education and enjoyment of youth hockey in the Tri-County area." Last year the CYHA awarded \$12,500 in scholarships to area youth hockey players in tri-county area. CYHA Board President Terri Mills attended the dinner and spoke about the wonderful work the CYHA has done in the past. She was thrilled the organization was chosen to be the beneficiary of the tournament.

The Legend Oaks Gives Back initiative was founded in 2008. The year-around initiative sponsor several events throughout the year to benefit the Lowcountry in need. Past events and donations have benefited The Alzheimer's Association, The ARK Alzheimer's Family and Support Services, Dorchester Children's Center,

Meals on Wheels of Summerville, MUSC Hollings Cancer Center, MUSC Children's Hospital, One80 Place, the Professional Tennis Registry Foundation and The South Carolina Junior Golf Association.
